Nursery 2	Thread pipe cleaners into colanders/plant pots/air flow balls Scoop/use spoons to put objects into containers Sponges to squeeze out water <b>Resources</b> Pipe cleaners, colanders, plant pots, air flow balls, scoops, dessert spoons, sponges <b>Vocabulary</b> Thread, scoop, squeeze,	Thread large wooden beads onto pipe cleaners Place large pegs on pegboards Complete 4-6 piece jigsaws <b>Resources</b> Large wooden beads, pipe cleaners, large pegs and peg boards, 4-6 piece jigsaws <b>Vocabulary</b> Thread, place	Thread pasta onto pipe cleaners Pop bubble wrap <b>Resources</b> Pasta, pipe cleaners, bubble wrap <b>Vocabulary</b> Pop! press	Thread cut up straws onto pipe cleaners Clip pegs onto cardboard shapes Complete 10 – 12 piece jigsaws <b>Resources</b> Cut up straws, pipe cleaners, pegs, cardboard shapes, 10-12 piece jigsaws <b>Vocabulary</b> Clip, peg on	Thread large wooden beads onto strings Balance small balls on golf tees <b>Resources</b> Wooden bead, strings, small balls, golf tees <b>Vocabulary</b> Balance	Thread leaves onto sticks Clip pegs onto ribbons Pipettes to squeeze out one drop of liquid Complete 16 piece jigsaws <b>Resources</b> Leaves, sticks, pegs, ribbons, pipettes, 16 piece jigsaws <b>Vocabulary</b> Clip, ribbons
Reception	Small matchsticks into small holes <b>Resources</b> Match sticks, objects with small holes to post into <b>Vocabulary</b> Push, post, focus	Small pegs onto peg boards Thread smaller beads (pony beads) onto string or onto pasta stuck into dough <b>Resources</b> Small pegs and peg boards, pony beads, string, pasta and dough <b>Vocabulary</b> Place, drop,	Tweezers and tongs to pick up small objects <b>Resources</b> Tweezers, tongs, small objects such as dry pasta <b>Vocabulary</b> Tweezers, pick up	Weaving ribbon Threading beads onto pipe cleaners to make bracelets <b>Resources</b> Weaving frames, ribbons, pony beads, pipe cleaners <b>Vocabulary</b> Ribbon, weave, in and out	Balancing marbles on golf tees Feed the tennis ball mouths (cut a slit in a ball and then squeeze to open it as a mouth shape <b>Resources</b> Golf tees, marbles, tennis balls, dry pasta <b>Vocabulary</b> Push, balance, feed, squeeze	Threading nuts and bolts Hanging objects onto trees/twigs, <b>Resources</b> Nuts and bolts <b>Vocabulary</b> Spin, thread, nut and bolt
