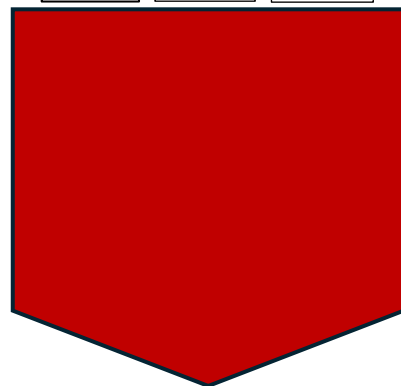


Celebrating our Success

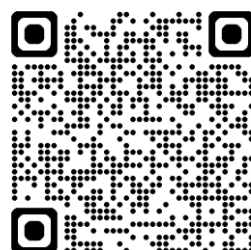
