Subject on a page: Art

Intent

Provide and encourage the opportunity for all children to have the skills required to be an artist in order to immerse themselves in and enjoy making art.

Inspire a love and curiosity of art that spans a range of genres, forms and cultures.

Implementation

We use Access Art to ensure that all year groups study a wide range of artists, develop specific artistic skills in a structured way. We have an art sketch book where all children record their ideas, thought and evaluations of their art work.

Impact

Children talk confidently about their learning in Art using appropriate and technical vocabulary. Children produce art work to a high standard using the skills that they have been taught. They are able to give constructive feedback to their peers.

How children with additional needs are supported

Pre teaching of art specific vocabulary and skills Adult support where needed Support in group work or individual area provided

How more able children are challenged

Encouragement to try new techniques, to take risks with their art work and try out new things. To critically evaluate their own work discussing the techniques that they have tried. Allow opportunity for children to decide how they will interpret the brief.

The focus in my subject this year is:

Improving children's art vocabulary.
Building a "buzz" around art by introducing whole school art projects.
Improve opportunities for children to talk about artists and their work

Monitoring plans for my subject this year are:

Pupil voice, book sharing with children Staff questionnaire, team teaching of art lessons

Previous improvements and impact

Introduction of AccessArt to support sequencing of lessons and whole school focus on teaching of art skills and vocabulary.

Current improvements

Building staff confidence and skills when teaching art. Focus and building art related vocabulary with the children. Introduction of whole school art projects.

Ideas for future Improvements

Introduction of extracurricular art opportunities

Pupil Voice

Children enjoy their art lessons and speak very positively about their art lessons. They are able to use subject specific vocabulary to describe their work and are proud of the work that they produce. "We can do lots of art in class" KS1 child.
