### Newsletter 5 Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020

Dear Parents / Carers

I hope you all had a lovely weekend despite the very wet weather on Saturday. Fingers crossed for a dry week in school!

#### **Class News**

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

**EYFS** – This week we have been thinking about how we have changed since we were babies. We have enjoyed exploring the Baby clinic in the role play area, looking after the babies, measuring and weighing them. In Forest Schools we went on a conker hunt and explored the Forest School area. All the children showed brilliant skills in independently putting on their all-in-one-suits and welly boots!

**Class 1** – In Class 1, children have been working hard on their number skills. Year 1s have been exploring one more and one less than a given number, whilst Year 2s have been exploring more about tens and ones. In art we have learnt about tints and shades. Literacy learning has focused on writing sentences about planet earth.

**Class 2** – This week we have used secondary sources to research more about the Stone Age. We used our research to write non-chronological reports on the Stone Age. For RE we went outside to take in and appreciate our beautiful surroundings before writing poetry about it. We have explored comparing and ordering numbers in Maths and in Art with Mrs Appleton we finished our portraits of famous people.

**Class 3** – This week we have started a new book looking at the life of refugees. This has inspired art work, descriptive writing and shape poetry. We have recapped and developed addition skills and drawn an annotated diagram of a switch in science. Our Topic time has been spent researching and recording features of the landscape in Eastern Europe.

#### Before and After School Childcare

Before and After School Childcare takes place in the new room off the hall. Pick up and drop off is made from the door on the Astroturf at the rear of the school building. Please follow the one-way system round the building to drop off or collect your child. To keep our children safe, please remember to close the gates behind you.

On Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> October School Photographs are being taken. If this applies to you, please come to school for 8.30am to have your children photographed together. Please be aware that you will need to wait outside until called. Only <u>ONE</u> adult will be allowed into school and a face covering must be worn at all times. Individual photographs and siblings who come to this school will be taken during the morning. Unfortunately, this year, if your baby or toddler attends a different school or nursery setting, they will not be able to have their photograph taken.

On 13th October Mr Duffy will run a Tri-Golf Tournament as an after-school activity for children to try out. This club is open to all ages but places will be limited as this is a one-off trial event. A letter has been sent out for parents to fill in and return to school.

Sadly, due to the pandemic, these events will be filmed and placed securely on our school website as opposed to a live performance with families. A password will be sent to parents to view the Harvest Festival and subsequent EYFS Nativity and KS1 Nativity.
