Dear Parents / Carers

I hope you have all had an enjoyable weekend - the autumnal colours are beautiful at this time of year.

Class News

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week we have been learning about weight. We have used the balance scales to compare the weight of different bears. We have read the story of Elmer and thought about how it would feel to be different. In our Forest School session we enjoyed making stickmen, learning to tie knots.

Class 1 – In Class 1, we have learnt about what animals eat and about the structure of different animals. In P.E. we have practised our running skills.

Class 2 – This week we have enjoyed investigating the permeability of different soil types and looking into fair testing. We had great fun in our football tournament on Tuesday. Year 4 have begun to work with Roman Numerals whilst Year 3 have looked at addition and subtraction crossing 10. In English we have learnt about subordinate clauses, complex sentences and descriptive writing.

Class 3 – This week we have also enjoyed the football tournament. We have been developing persuasive language through drama and letter writing. In Maths, we have been practising subtraction and our multiplication tables. During music, we looked at how music is used in animation.

Harvest – Food Bank Donations

This year for Harvest, we will be supporting Ripon Community House Food Support. Food support provides emergency parcels for people in crisis in Ripon, Boroughbridge and the surrounding villages.
