Dear Parents / Carers

It is a busy week in school with Remembrance and National Roast Dinner Day on Wednesday and Children in Need non-uniform day on Friday - £1 donation.

As a school we will take the time to reflect and remember the importance of Remembrance on Wednesday as we observe a two-minute silence at 11am.

Class News

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week in EYFS we have been writing short sentences using the tricky words 'the' and 'l'. In maths we have been finding different ways of making 3. We have been exploring different ways of printing, making firework pictures using pipe cleaners and paint.

Class 1 – In Class 1, we have begun our learning about Traditional Tales. As a class, we have started learning Little Red Riding Hood off by heart and have focused on writing the beginning of the story.

Class 2 – In Class 2 this week we have been writing the ending to our Stone Age stories. We have looked at adding and subtracting using exchanging in maths. Our artwork this week saw us finishing our Picasso inspired portraits. In PE we have been developing our skills in how we move our bodies. We have looked at the Earth's core in Geography.

Class 3 – In Class 3 we have been completing our class book, 'The Journey' by writing a message in a bottle. We displayed our science results as line graphs and found out about what happened in Chernobyl. During maths sessions, we practised long multiplication to solve problems.

National Roast Dinner Day on Wednesday 11th November

On Wednesday, our school cook is making a special school dinner to celebrate Roast Dinner Day! Children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 can have this for free and children in Years 3-6 can order the lunch on the day. The menu is as follows:
