Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week in EYFS we have started to learn about winter. We have looked at our new book 'Winter's Sleep'. We have explored ice and made ice sculptures to hang outside. We have begun to look at why animals hibernate.

Class 1 – This week in Class 1, we have begun our learning about the history of flight. We have sequenced events on a timeline and designed our own flying machine. In English, we have begun to read 'The Way Back Home' and learn the story off by heart.

Class 2 – In Class 2 this week, we have we have begun reading our new class text 'Charlotte's Web'. We have looked at some of the main characters including Wilbur, Fern and Charlotte. Class 3 – This week Class 3 have been investigating the rainforest setting of our new guided reading book, 'Journey to the River Sea' and writing a book review of our last book. In Maths we have been learning about decimals and charts. Our artwork has been based around a rainforest scene.
