Class News

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week has been very busy in EYFS. It was lovely to welcome all the children back in Monday and we have been working hard to get back into our routines. We have been looking at 3D shapes – learning the names of different shapes and talking about their properties. We have done some super art work, looking at the flower paintings of Georgia O Keeffe, using pencil and oil pastels. We all enjoyed the balance bike afternoon on Tuesday, practising our gross motor skills and balancing.

Class 1 – This week, Class 1 children have enjoyed being back together and they have enjoyed exchanging the friendship cards they made during their last week of remote learning. This week, we have revisited our learning on explorers and have begun to learn about Christopher Columbus. In art, children have learnt about texture and have created art work based on a painting by Van Gogh. In P.E lessons, children have enjoyed developing their football skills.

Class 2 – It has been wonderful to see all of the children back in school this week. In English we have all written different stories with the title "I should never have gone there" thinking about what genres the title makes us think about. In maths we have continued our learning on fractions and measure. We have completed assessments in the latter part of the week but we have also found time to design and produce wonderful artwork and Mother's Day cards.

Class 3 – In Class 3 this week, we have enjoyed learning alongside each other again. We have taken time to discuss some positive actions we can take to improve our own feelings of wellbeing and build resilience. Alongside our end of term assessments, we have found lots of time to be creative. We have made pictures in the surrealist style of the Spanish artist, Joan Miró and found out about

his life and what inspired his work. During topic, we have looked at how explorers found out about the ancient Maya civilisation and looked for evidence in the sketches drawn at that time. We have also made up our own endings for our class reading book and we are having fun reading the last chapters together as a class.

Parents Evening will take place next week. Class teachers will send appointment times via the class email system and appointments are for 10 minutes.

Balance Bikes – EYFS

On Tuesday afternoon all of the children in EYFS enjoyed taking part in a balance bike session. The children put on their helmets, chose their bikes and were off! They practised balance biking in small and large spaces (looking out for obstacles), biking around cones, under limbos and over ramps. By the end of the session the children had made super progress and all were keen to show off their balance biking skills – some children even advanced on to bikes with pedals!

We are working on expanding the number of non-fiction books we have in school and our aspiration is to have a full lending library in place for the children.
