Dear Parents / Carers

I hope you all had a super weekend enjoying the beautiful weather. We are all waiting to hear the announcement regarding the COVID restrictions today and in due course I will update you with school plans for the rest of the term. As always, our plans will need to be in line with the North Yorkshire risk assessment procedures but please be assured that as soon as I get clarity over what we can do and how we can do it, I will write to you to confirm how we will proceed.

Class News

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week we have started our new topic "Life Cycles and Living Things – where does a butterfly come from?" We have started the topic by looking at the life cycle of a frog. We have learnt facts about frogs from books and videos. We have all put together a frog life cycle and enjoyed exploring our small world frog pond. In maths we have spent the week learning about doubling. We can recognise dominoes that are doubles/not doubles and are all gaining confidence is saying what the doubles are for numbers up to five, and beyond. In PE we have started practising early athletics skills and this week concentrated on different types of jumps.

Class 1 – This week class 1 have been reading the book The Koala Who Could. We have learnt the story off by heart and sequenced the story using time connectives. In Design Technology, we have begun to explore puppets. We have investigated what they are made of and how they are made. Over the next few weeks children will develop their textiles skills in order to make their own. In P.E we have begun our athletics unit and have been developing our running skills.

Class 2 – This week in Class 2 we have begun our new Geography topic looking at the Human Geography of China. In English we have studied a non-fiction text all about the depths of the ocean and what is hidden beneath the surface, paying attention to the features of non-fiction writing and responding to questions about the text. Our Maths learning this week has been all about angles, spotting different types of angles and beginning to measure them. We have also been stepping up practising our production which we cannot wait to perform for you soon.

Class 3 – In Class 3 this week, we have started a new topic about coasts. We have been producing maps of the British Isles to show where some of the main settlements are around the coastline. We now just about know all our lines for our Macbeth production, so we have been acting these out and

adding dances with the help of our dance coach. This week, we have also designed a poster about ourselves, written in French. During maths, we have been looking at statistics and during literacy, we have been exploring the features of effective persuasive language. We are now writing texts to persuade Macbeth to either kill or not kill Banquo.

<u>Olivia Mulligan – poet – 23rd June</u>

BBC Radio York's Poet Laureate and former pupil of Dishforth CE Primary School, Olivia Mulligan, has been appointed to write a poem which is to be scribed on a stone sculpture that acknowledges the involvement of the military during the Second World War. Olivia has asked the children in Key Stage 2 at both Dishforth CE Primary and Dishforth Airfield Schools to be involved in this project and is therefore going to work with the children at Dishforth CE Primary on Wednesday 23rd June.

Music for Life – Friday 25th June

On Friday 25th June the children are due to listen to a concert from musicians through Music for Life and the older children are going to take part in a workshop to develop their music skills.
