# Newsletter 38 Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2021

#### Dear Parents / Carers

I appreciate that the news over the weekend has affected many families as a result of a confirmed case of COVID within the school community. On Saturday I spoke to the Public Health Officer for schools to ensure that I followed all the guidance and procedures that are necessary in this situation. The letters that were sent on Saturday were standard letters and written by Public Health England (PHE). Schools are required to send them to families as quickly as possible when there is a confirmed case of COVID in a school setting. One letter is written for people who are direct contacts and one letter is for the rest of the school community.

I am also writing to ask for your help and support moving forward for this week and next week. Public Health England have advised that it would be very helpful if parents and carers took a lateral flow test on themselves twice a week until the end of term. If a parent tests positive on a lateral flow test they would then need to book a PCR test for the family including the children.

## **Class News**

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

**EYFS** – We were all very excited to see that our butterflies had emerged from their cocoons. We watched them in the butterfly net for a day and then decided that it was time to let them go free. We all enjoyed watching the butterflies in the outdoor area. Some children were very lucky that the butterflies chose to come and rest on their hands for a while. We have written our own versions of "The Very Hungry Caterpillar" this week as well as working on our problem solving skills in maths.

Class 1 – In Literacy Class 1 have been learning off by heart the story of Tiddalik. They have developed their reading comprehension skills and have begun to plan a character description. In design technology, Class 1 have worked hard on their puppets and add their finishing touches. Children have enjoyed using their puppets to perform a puppet show. In maths children have learnt more about position and direction and have worked to describe movement on a grid. In our Geography lesson, children have been finding out about the weather in Australia and how this compares to the weather in the U.K.

**Class 2** – We have had a fantastic week in Class 2 this week. In Maths we have used our time recapping our learning from this year. In our literacy we have written diary entries in the role of Chulak, one of the main characters of our class text. For Geography, we have created booklets all

about The Great Wall of China, using our research skills. In Art we have completed still life drawings of fruit and vegetables and in PE we have been practising to be ready for sports day.

Class 3 - We have recorded two versions of our Macbeth production. Everybody performed extremely well and the costumes were fantastic. We have also had our puberty talk and we attended a live online assembly about water safety from Yorkshire Water's Education Team. This week, we have been learning about colours in French and about volume, area and perimeter in maths. During our topic session, we explored the features of our coastline and how these features are formed. We have continued our journalistic account of the Battle of Dunsinane, from the closing scenes of Macbeth, during literacy.

The links for Class 3's production of Macbeth will be sent out to their families this week.

## **COVID Restrictions – end of term plans**

As there is only one week left in school when the restrictions lift on next Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July, we are following advice and maintaining our COVID systems for the last week of term. As a result, staggered start and end times for the school day, along with bubbles will remain in place for the last week.

# Sports Day - Tuesday 20th July

Our Sports day will take place on **Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2021 at 10am**. Whilst we fully appreciate that the government restrictions around the pandemic are lifting from the 19th, we will be running Sports Day in a way that is in line with our COVID systems. I discussed this with Public Health England on Saturday as well as North Yorkshire Public Health today and it was said that we can go ahead with our plans as the isolating children are back in school on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July, with a proviso that the plan will be kept under review in case of further COVID cases or any changes in government Sports Day announcements today.

As things stand, the plan is as follows:

- Parents / carers are welcome to watch there will be an allotted place clearly marked out
  on the field. Spectators are kindly asked to respect the feelings of others and to maintain a
  reasonable distance. Spectators are to stay in this area only. Please do not go to the finish
  line or cross the track where the classes will be sitting.
- The weather forecast is looking like it will be warm please ensure your child / children have sun cream on them before coming to school and they must bring a sun hat. There is no shade on the field.
- Please bring your own chair or rug if you would like to sit down
- There will be no access into school no toilet facilities for spectators
- The events will run like they have in previous years at the school. Nursery children will run in the first race and then they will go back to the classroom.
- Children in Reception Year 6 have been allocated a colour team and they will wear a colour band to represent this team (red / yellow / blue / green). Different races will take place and the winning colour team will receive a trophy at the end.
- Sports Day will start promptly at 10am. Please ensure that your child / children has their PE kit and trainers in school.

Thank you to Mr Duffy for organising the event.

<u>Leavers' Assembly</u>: The Year 6 Leavers' Assembly is on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> July at 2pm for the Year 6 children and their parents.

<u>Transition:</u> A whole school transition session will now take place on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July in the morning where the children will have the opportunity to spend some time with the class teacher they are going to have in September.

<u>Start and end times of the school day</u>: The staggered start and end times of the school day will remain in place for the rest of this term. It is hoped that in September we will be able to have one start and one finish time as previously shared in past newsletters: 8.45am – 3.15pm. Details will be shared before we break up for the summer when we receive information from the DfE.
