Class News

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week we enjoyed returning to school and seeing our friends again. We have thought about moving on and sharing information about ourselves with our new teacher, Miss Paterson. We had made moving puppets using split pins and unicorn masks. We all enjoyed taking part in sports day, and the ice lollies we had afterwards.
