## **Newsletter 6 Monday 11<sup>th</sup> October 2021**

Dear Parents,

I hope you have all had an enjoyable weekend with the glorious weather- the autumnal colours are beautiful at this time of year.

## **Class News:**

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

**EYFS** – This week we have enjoyed learning and performing the poem Little Rabbit Foo Foo. We have made props, such as rabbit ears and magic wands to help us act the story out. In Maths, we have been making repeating patterns using natural resources and beads.

**Class 1** – In Class 1 this week, we have been learning to write our own diary entries based on 'Vlad and The Great Fire of London'. We have linked this to our current topic on The Great Fire of London and looked carefully at Samuel Pepys diary for ideas to inspire us. We paid particular attention to ensure we included interesting nouns, verbs and adjectives in our work. In Maths, we have focused on addition and subtraction stories. We also thought about different ways to check our calculations. The children had a lot of fun in Forest Schools, making their own bread and toasting it on the fire! We also planted daffodils in our playground. Meanwhile in Science, we have been exploring the changing state of materials and have researched the scientist John McAdam.

Class 2 – What a great week we have had in Class 2! In English, we have become poetry critics, looking in depth at the poetry of John Lyons and analysing what we like and dislike about some of his poems. We learnt to investigate theme and structure too. In our Topic work, we have written balanced arguments to try to persuade the people of London to use more public transport, rather than driving. In Science with Mrs Blyton, we have experimented with different liquids and the effect they have on our teeth by leaving hard-boiled eggs in a variety of liquids to see how the eggs change.

**Class 3** – This week in Literacy, Class 3 have worked on using different sentence openers to engage the reader. Children have enjoyed planning and writing narrative linked to our class text. In Maths lessons, children have focused on their addition and subtraction skills and using these to solve problems. In our topic lesson, we have read myths and legends and we have thought about what evidence these stories tell us about Ancient Greece.

As with previous years the family photographs are to be taken first from 8.30am, these are for children in school who have siblings who are <u>not</u> at school. **EYFS** – The ribbon this week goes to someone who is very enthusiastic about learning her sounds and she tries hard in everything she does. Well done, Connie!


**Class 1** – The ribbon this week goes to someone who has had an excellent attitude towards his learning. Well done, Bobby!
