Covid Update

I am updating you to let you know that we have an increasing number of cases of Covid within our school staff and across every class in school.

At this stage we are operating as normal and, as I have stated in previous letters, this is our priority however I feel it is going to be a very challenging couple of weeks. If cases continue to rise and we have a significant number of staff off, then school would not be in a position to operate fully and we would then need to put alternative measures in place.

In the event of siginifcant numbers of staff off school, we may need to close class bubbles and remote learning would take place for these children. Classes in school may also need to be merged.

Children of critical workers and vulnerable children would still be able to come to school. If you are unsure if you fall in to this category, please click on the link below which gives you all the information you need.

Class News:

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week we have continued learning about Penguins and Antarctica. We have enjoyed exploring our role play area which has been a Polar Explorers Work Station. We have made binoculars and telescopes to help us view penguins in the wild. In Maths we have continued to explore number 5 and we have used numicon to explore number bonds for 5. In forest schools we made bird feeders using cereal and pipe cleaners and we have hung our feeders on the trees around school. Next week we will be learning about Chinese New Year.

Class 1 – In Class 1 this week, we have been learning about ' What the Ladybird Heard' by Julia Donaldson. We looked carefully at past and present tense, expanded noun phrases and interesting punctuation that we can add to our writing. We acted out the story and went on a sound walk to see what we could hear around our school. We then wrote our own versions of What the Ladybird might hear if she came to Dishforth Primary. In Maths, we have focused on multiplication and division. Year 1s have been learning how to count in 2s, 5s and 10s fluently whilst solving different mathematical problems. Year 2s have looked at how to use the multiplication symbol in their calculations and have begun to explore the concept of division. In Topic work this week, we have explored different kinds of houses and homes that we might find in our local area. We used our class collected junk to make our own houses and homes that our class teddy bear might want to live in. In Science, we continued to explore our new project. We thought about life cycles and researched the life cycles of different animals, including humans. We then put this information into our own diagrams. Finally, in Art we have begun to explore Aboriginal painting. In particular, we have studied 'The Dreaming' and what that means in Aboriginal culture. We then created our own dot paintings, using the different symbols that Aboriginals use.

Class 2 – In Class 2 this week we have continued to work hard on our times tables work. Year 4 have been looking at multiplying more than 2 numbers while year 3 have worked on their 3, 4- and 8- times tables. In literacy we have completed the reading of our class text and have written book reviews. For topic, we investigated the path of Roman roads in Britain. We also really enjoyed our swimming session this week.

Class 3 – Class three have had an exciting end to this week, finishing our published rhyming couplet poems. We have worked hard in maths looking at the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. In geography, we have made our own biomes in a bag, ready to observe over the next two weeks. Additionally, the children have started our music this week, based on a jazz topic.

White Rose Maths – 1 minute-maths app – for information

The writers of the maths scheme we use throughout school, White Rose Maths, have designed an app for use both in class and at home, called 1-Minute Maths. The app helps children build greater number confidence and fluency through targeted practice in engaging, one-minute chunks.

This first version of the app is aimed at Key Stage 1 pupils with individual one-minute tasks focusing on adding and subtracting – and on 'Subitising', the skill of instantly recognising the number of items in a group without counting. Multiplication and division are going to be added soon.

The app is free and is really useful for building number fluency and confidence and compliments the teaching strategies used in class – worth a look!
