# Newsletter 28 Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2022

Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you have all had a great Easter break and enjoyed the time off – it certainly seemed like we had all four seasons of weather over the two weeks. It's lovely to see the children today who are full of chatter as to what they have been up to!

# <u>Welcome</u>

A very warm welcome to Olivia and Florence this week:

## **Class News:**

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

**EYFS** – This week we have learning about the Easter Story. We have learned about what happened to Jesus at Easter and why this is a special time for Christians. We were all very excited to go to church and experience a coach journey. Mrs Chaplin was very proud of the way we sat and sang in church. We have enjoyed making Easter crafts this week.

**Class 1** – In Class 1 this week, the children spent time analysing instructions and the important features they should include. We then created our own set of instructions on how to make an Easter card, remembering to include bossy verbs, conjunctions and appropriate punctuation. In Maths, Year 1s have continued to learn about money, applying what they have learnt to different problem-solving challenges. Year 2s completed their unit on statistics, learning about the importance of bar charts and demonstrating their understanding in an end of unit assessment. In Art and R.E, we made our own Easter cards and thought about the importance of Jesus' life and his teachings. We then created our own Easter prayers which the children took great joy in creating.

**Class 2** – In Class 2 this week we have really enjoyed the build up to Easter. We loved going to church on Wednesday and watching the production of 3 Trees. On Thursday we performed our production to the school which gave us the opportunity to showcase all the practice that we have put in this term. In English this week we have written our own adaptations of the Roald Dahl classic - The BFG and in Maths Year 3 have learnt about perimeter while Year 4 have begun to look at decimals. In RE we have completed a guided reading session with questions all about the Easter Story and in Science we recapped all of the learning we have achieved this term.

**Class 3** – Class 3 have been working on statistics in maths, looking at tables and line graphs. The children used Shackleton's journey as inspiration to write their own adventure narratives in literacy this week. We have finished our computing topic (based on film) and designed their own stop frame animation about Shackleton. The year 5's have worked extremely hard putting on a wonderful performance as part of our Easter service at church.
