Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you all had a super half term break and enjoyed the very mild weather. It is always a lovely couple of months with the run up to the festive season in school and over the coming weeks there will be further information to share with you. This week we have school photograph morning on Wednesday, the details are in the newsletter, and clubs resume until week ending Friday 25th November.

Class News:

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week in EYFS we have enjoyed looking at the book 'Stickman". We have joined in with telling the story and have picked out the rhyming words. We all enjoyed taking part in our Harvest festival, learning our dings and the actions, and joining in confidently.

Class 1 – In class 1 this week we have been really focussing on reading and phonics. The children are working hard to make good phonic choices when writing and trying to use their voices expressively when reading. We have been very interested to find out about Mosques in RE and to find out how Muslims pray, we have been comparing this to how Christians pray.

Class 2 – This week in class 2 we have been preparing for Harvest Festival. In RE we have written prayers, telling God what makes us thankful at Harvest time. In English we have written Harvest themed poetry and our artwork this week we took our Still Life drawing knowledge and drew a Harvest fruits still life, then used oil pastels to add colour. Our Maths this week has seen us continue our addition and subtraction work and in Science we have recapped all of our learning from this half term.

Class 3 – This week Class 3 have been perfecting our prayers for the harvest festival and planning our story opening for our literacy work. In maths, the children have been working hard at long multiplication and division. We have created a double page spread about a country in Europe and compared it to the United Kingdom. In art, we have worked on shading and recapped our line work from last week.
