# Newsletter 16 Monday 9th January 2023

Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you have all had a lovely weekend.

## **Class News:**

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

**EYFS** – This week in Early Years it has been lovely to welcome everyone back after the Christmas holidays. We have enjoyed talking about our Christmas experiences. We have been learning about the season of winter and have been talking about what winter is like and how it is different to other times of the year. We have made ice cubes and have observed what happens to ice over time.

Class 1 – We have had a fantastic start to the new year in class 1 beginning with some poetry writing about the galaxy. We have asked the question "Did people really go to the moon?" and looked at lots of different sources of information to help us to make a decision. We have also begun to explore the United Kingdom, learning where Scotland is and learning the seas that surround it. We have also learned about the winter. We looked around the school grounds and made notes about the changes that we could see. It has been a busy first few days back and the children have all been working very well.

Class 2 – It has been lovely to have the children back in school this week. We have introduced our new class text - Journey by Aaron Becker. We have looked at the story so far and added speech and written a setting description. In Maths we are looking at multiplication with year 3 looking at arrays and recapping multiples of 2s 5s and 10s while year 4 are looking at 6s 7s and 9s. We began looking at our new History topic of the Iron Age by looking at how the Stone Age evolved through the Bronze Age.

**Class 3** – Class 3 have had a lovely start back to the spring term this year. They have finished perfecting their newspaper article from last half term and have been working incredibly hard in maths this week. The Y5 children have recapped adding fractions and Y6 have hit the ground running with converting metric units. We have had fun retrieving some fun facts about our previous history and science topics and started our PSHE this half term.

Children in **Class 3** are going to be undertaking Forest Schools on a Tuesday starting next week, 10<sup>th</sup> January. Please can children bring into school a waterproof coat, tracksuit bottoms and trainers / wellies – something that you don't mind getting wet and dirty!!

#### Swimming Class 2 - January - this Thursday



School swimming will continue to take place at Thirsk swimming pool. **Year 3 and Year 4 children start on Thursday 12**<sup>th</sup> **January**. Please ensure your child has swimwear, goggles and a towel (named). It is helpful if girls wear socks and not tights on swimming days. Due to the layout and number of cubicles at Thirsk swimming baths, some children need to share a cubicle in order to change before and after the lesson. If any parents have questions

or queries about this then please don't hesitate to speak to Mrs Lyon.

The cost of swimming is **£5.00 each week**, this is a voluntary contribution which School has already heavily subsidised due to rising prices from the bus company and constraints imposed by Thirsk Pool.

## **Emergency Procedure for School Closure – weather related / loss of utilities**

It is rare, however there are occasions where it has been necessary to close schools because of inclement weather, no electricity or because of lack of heating, so I would like to bring to your attention the procedures I will follow if this event occurs now that we are heading towards winter:
