Topic



Our topic this half term in history is social justice. In geography, we will use geography skills and fieldwork to look at costal environments.

Science

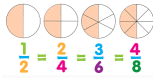
Science this term will begin with a review of rocks and fossils, and then move on to inheritance and the theory of evolution. We will investigate the properties of rocks and soils and we will explore what fossils can tell us about living things that once inhabited the Earth. We will look at how offspring vary and are not identical to their parents. We will also identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environments. Later in the term we will find out more about animals, when the focus will be on the changes that take place as humans develop through to old age.



Art/ DT

In art the children will be studying Michelle Hughes (local artist from York). They will be having a go at printing, including exploring lino printing. In Design and Technology, they are going to be looking at textiles combining a combination of 2D fabric shapes to make a 3D product.

Maths



In maths, we begin the term by learning about statistics, geometry and position and direction. The Y6 children will have some revision time before their SATs in May.



English

We begin the half term reading Macbeth by William Shakespeare and after half-term, we are learning about Town Is by the Sea by Joanne Schwartz. We will be looking at poetry and opportunities to write descriptive pieces.

P.E

We are going to be doing athletics in summer term, followed by rounders after the half-term break.

Children will learn about 'me and my relationships, including moving on and transitions'. They will look at peer influence and making people feel included. The children also look at friendships, how to treat others and 'Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)'.
