



DISHFORTH C.E. PRIMARY SCHOOL CHARGING AND REMISSION POLICY

Statement of Intent

The Governors are committed to a free and comprehensive education which ensures equality of access and opportunity to all pupils.

General

- No charge will be made in respect of admission to the school
- No charge will be made for entering a pupil for any prescribed public examination for which the pupil has been prepared by the school
- A charge will be payable for before and after school child care
- A charge will be payable for hours in nursery over the funded hours (currently 30 or 15 for children 3 years and over) and for lunchtime supervision

Voluntary Contributions

- To enable school funds to go further, parents and others may be asked for voluntary contributions for visits and/or coaches/mini buses
- The school will have the right to cancel an activity if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to make the activity possible and this will be made clear from the outset. Where an activity is counted as wholly during the school day, or is required by the National Curriculum, no child will be excluded because his/her parents are unwilling to pay a voluntary contribution
- May charge for board and lodgings on residential courses

School Property

The Governors reserve the right to charge parents if their child is found to be responsible for the wilful destruction of school property

Lettings

Charges will be made in accordance with the Lettings policy for hire of the school
